Arts Scholar Liveryman Ian Kelly has arranged a visit to Highgate cemetery where he was former Chairman of The Friends of Highgate Cemetery and is now Vice President.

After touring the West cemetery, and before lunch, attendees will be welcome to spend some time in the East Cemetery where Marx (Karl, not Groucho), George Eliot, Douglas Adams, Frank Matcham, William Friesse-Green, Sir Ralph Richardson, and a host of other well-known notables are interred. Numbers are restricted to 20.

Highgate Cemetery has some of the finest funerary architecture in the country. It is a place of peace and contemplation where a romantic profusion of trees, memorials and wildlife flourish. Opened in 1839, Highgate is the UK's most famous cemetery and reflects the Victorians' romantic attitude to death, and its presentation, by the creation of a labyrinth of Egyptian Sepulchres and a wealth of Gothic tombs & buildings.



It represents a microcosm of the Victorian age and entombs poets, artists, medics, sportsmen, radicals, entrepreneurs, princes and paupers.

In places the ground is steep and uneven therefore suitable shoes/boots are advised. Please also check the weather forecast to be prepared for the conditions if necessary.

Following the tour, participants will retire to the Cote Restaurant on Highgate Hill for a 2-course lunch with wine.

The cost of the visit and meal is £45 (incl VAT). Nearer the time menu choices will be sent to all attending and directions to the meeting point.
